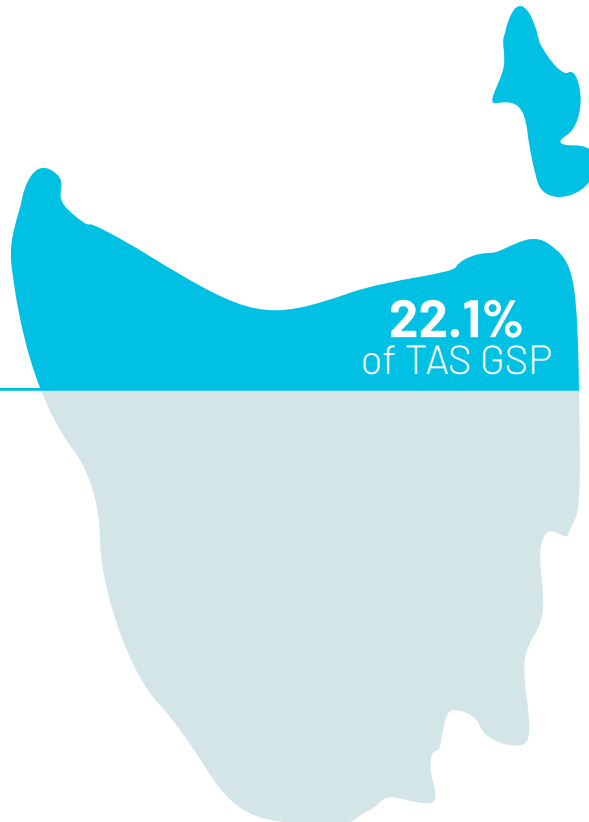
A Pillar of Tasmania's Economy

Derive their wage from the property industry directly and indirectly

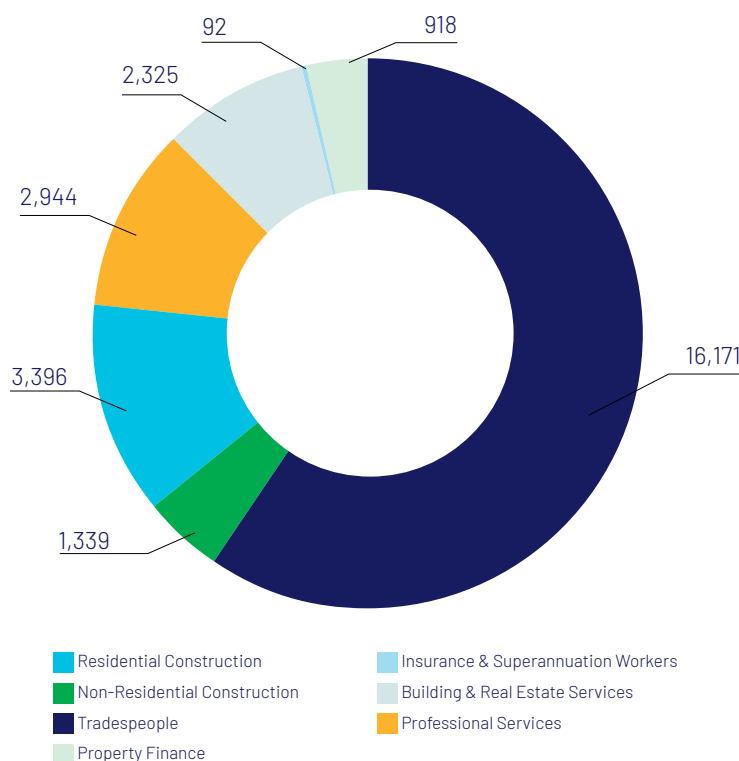
Building prosperity
